Financial Report: Stacia Wert –Gray reported that the club has income of \$107,208.59, and expenses of \$107,249.86, resulting in a net loss of \$41.27. This is before the Silent Auction today, and the new and renewed memberships received today.

Membership: Currently at 140 members, asking for renewals and new memberships to be submitted as soon as possible.

Show Report: Stacia Wert-Gray reported that there were 23 shows this past year at 4 facilities, including recognized, schooling and Western Dressage. In 2022 the schedule is expanding the number of WD shows. The entire 2022 schedule has been published.
